



## RISK & HAZARD MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS

The Risk & Hazard Management Program consists of several courses and activity based awareness sessions. This provides the client flexibility in either the undertaking of the complete program or specific awareness session or course associated with the training program.

### **Safety Awareness Sessions (Theory & Activity Based)**

- Group participants – up to 20
- Duration per Session – Avg 1hr

The above awareness sessions are designed to provide a foundation of basic safety awareness and exposure to risks within the workplace. The sessions progressively leads onto the below outlined courses.

### **Conduct Local Risk Assessment**

- Group participants – 10
- Duration per Session – Avg 4hrs

Participants will develop a basic hands on understanding of identifying hazards within their working environment and to identify, consequence and potential control measures.

### **Apply Risk Management Process – 1 day**

- Group participants – 10
- Duration per Session – 1 day

This course covers the application of risk management processes in resources and infrastructure industries. It includes identifying hazards; assessing and identifying unacceptable risk; identifying and recommending treatments; contributing to the implementation of treatments; and reviewing safety system documentation.

### **Introduction to Drilling – Non Drilling Personnel – 2 days**

- Group participants – 10
- Duration per Session – 1 day

The structure of this course is to provide a basic understanding of current Drilling Processes and the hazards which are involved within the Drilling Industry and open communication between the Drill Crew and Non-Drilling personnel that may be involved or associated with Drilling Process. The training program has the benefit of being able to be structured to suit the direct needs of each client.
